The City of Bartlett water system PWS ID 2460006 has violated the monitoring /reporting requirements set by Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) in Title 30, Texas Administrative Code (30 TAC), Section 290, Subchapter F. Public water systems are required to properly disinfect water before distribution, maintain acceptable disinfection residuals within the distribution system, monitor the distribution residual at various locations throughout the distribution system, and report the results of that monitoring to the TCEQ on a quarterly basis.

Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not your drinking water is safe from microbial contamination.

This/These violation occurred in the monitoring period: **Second Quarter of 2017**

We are taking the following actions to address this issue:

Monitoring was actually done- however the reporting was not done. We have since reported the results and this letter is the final requirement of notifying our residents of the violation.

Please share this information with all people who drink this water, especially those who may not have received this notice directly (i.e., people in apartments, nursing homes, schools, and businesses). You can do this by posting this notice in a public place or distributing copies by hand or mail.
