## **RESOLUTION NO.**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BARTLETT, TEXAS, ESTABLISHING SIGNATORIES ON ALL CITY OF BARTLETT BANK ACCOUNTS AT BANCORPSOUTH; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; DESIGNATING THE SIGNATORIES ON ALL CITY OF BARTLETT, TEXAS FINANCIAL DOCUMENTS; AND ORDAINING OTHER PROVISIONS RELATED TO THE SUBJECT MATTER HEREOF.

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds it is in the best interest of the City of Bartlett, Texas (the "City") to amend the designated signatories for all of the City's bank accounts, effective November 16, 2020, in order to add additional designated signatories as listed herein on all of the City of Bartlett bank accounts at BancorpSouth and removing unseated members of City Council and former city employees as signatories in accordance with the Order of Censure issued by the City Council on August 16, 2019.

# NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BARTLETT, TEXAS:

**Section 1.** <u>Findings Incorporated</u>. The findings recited above are incorporated as if fully set forth in the body of this Resolution.

**Section 2.** <u>Signatories</u>. The City Council of the City of Bartlett, Texas designates the following officers of the City as additional signatories on the City's bank accounts at BancorpSouth:

City Administrator | City Secretary Joseph Resendez City Council Member Jesse Luna City Council Member Stephanie Romero

As additional signatories, these officials will be allowed to execute and submit applications, open accounts, deposit and withdraw funds, designate other authorized representatives, and take all other action required or permitted by the City under an agreement with the financial institution created by the application, in the name and on behalf of the City, and when approved by the City Council.

**Section 3.** <u>Savings/Repealing Clause</u>. All resolutions, or parts thereof, that are in conflict or inconsistent with any provision of this Resolution or the City's Public Investment Policy, as amended, and adopted in accordance with Chapter 2256, Texas Government Code, the Public Funds Investment Act, are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and the provisions of this Resolution and the City's Public Investment Policy, as amended, shall be and remain controlling as to the matters regulated herein.

**Section 4.** <u>Severability Clause</u>. Should any of the clauses, sentences, paragraphs, sections or parts of this Resolution be deemed invalid, unconstitutional, or unenforceable by a court of law or administrative agency with jurisdiction over the matter, such action shall not be construed to affect any other valid portion of this Resolution.

Section 5. <u>Effective Date</u>. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval.
