

## Mobile Food Vendors and Establishments (MFVE) Permit

The City of Bartlett allows Mobile Food Vendors and Establishments (MFVEs), such as food trucks and food truck parks, to be placed on some sites as accessory uses only if the site has an MFVE Permit. The MFVE Permit is eligible for Commercial Zones within the city limits. Eligibility for Residential Zones will be considered on a case-by-case basis and require City Council approval. Eligibility for City-Owned Property will be considered on a case-by-case basis and require Mayor approval.

**MFVE Permits** are issued by the month up to the end of the current calendar year (January-December). MFVE Permit fees will be prorated for remaining months in the calendar year.

\*If the Property Owner of the Mobile Food Establishment pays the permit fees in advance to reserve/open Mobile Food Vendor spots/booths/locations on an approved site, any and all Mobile Food Vendors occupying any spots/booths/locations at any given time must comply with all permit requirements.

Requirements:				
	Electric meter(s) is inspected and active for each MFVE.			
	Water connection(s) must have vacuum breaker for each MFVE.			
	MFVE(s) may not dispose of grey water or grease into city sewer or be connected to city sewer under			
	any circumstance.			
	MFVE(s) may only be connected to City of Bartlett utilities.			
	MFVE(s) must be sub-metered or part of the property owner's utilities. MFVE(s) may not have			
	individual utility account(s).			
	MFVE(s) may only operate from 6:00 AM to 11:00 PM, Monday – Sunday.			
	Any music or sound system must be kept at an appropriate noise level. City Administration and Bartlett Police Department reserve the right to enforce the reduction of noise up to and including complete shut-off. Failure to comply with noise reduction mandates will result in revocation of MFVE Permit.			
	MFVE(s) must provide current Williamson County Fire Marshal Mobile Food Vendor Permit Certificate or approval of equivalent from Williamson County Fire Marshal.			
	MFVE(s) must provide current Retail Food Establishment Inspection Report from the Williamson			
	County and Cities Health District or Food Dealer's Permit from the Bell County Public Health District.			
	MFVE(s) must provide copy of active Sales and Use Tax Permit.			
	MFVE(s) must provide copy of active Texas Food Safety Manager Certification.			
	<ul> <li>MFVE(s) must provide copy of Driver's License or Proof of Identification of Property Owner or Applicant.</li> </ul>			
	MFVE(s) must provide copy of list of goods being sold and/or a food menu.

## Site description notes:

- New electric meters or connections to city water or wastewater infrastructure are prohibited. Existing and/or pre-approved Water and Electric connections only.
- MFVEs may not be placed on public parking lots, streets, access drives, fire lanes, or improved alleys.
- MFVEs may not occupy parking spaces needed to meet the required minimum spaces for the primary use.
- MFVEs may not be placed on sidewalks in or along the right-of-way without prior approval from the City. Approval may only be granted if a minimum of 5 ft. of sidewalk remains free of obstruction.
- MFVEs shall be located a minimum of 12 ft. from fire hydrants and 5 ft. from any utility box, ADA ramp, or building entrance.
